The lack of proper security measures and surveillance equipment leaves these vulnerable pioneers in a constant state of fear and uncertainty.

The Hebron Hills Regional Council is responsible for overseeing the various emergency teams and supporting security activities for the small communities in the region. From patrolling the rugged terrain of the Judean hills to responding to urgent emergencies, the Hebron Hills security department must be ready to handle any situation that arises. This is why an all-terrain vehicle is essential for effectively patrolling the expansive region, allowing for quick and safe access to even the most remote hills and valleys where terrorists may be plotting attacks. The vehicle must also be capable of handling a variety of driving conditions, including snowy weather in the winter months. Additionally, given the sensitive security needs in the area, the vehicle must be equipped with emergency lights and towing capabilities.

As the nature of terrorist threats continues to evolve in the region, security measures must adapt accordingly. The new vehicle must be equipped with a rugged topper for transporting essential medical and search and rescue equipment.
