



# Mitzpe Dani

## PROTECTING OUR BOUNDARIES

Our little car stuttered a bit as it labored up the steep path. From the road, I almost couldn't make out the hilltop community of Mitzpe Dani, nestled as it was between the folds of a windswept mountain 635 meters above sea level. We had already passed a sign welcoming us to Mitzpe Dani, and still no sign of the community. But then we crested a ridge, and suddenly it came into view—a tiny dirt-pathed community, immersed in nature and made up of rings of both permanent and temporary homes. Strong winds set the tall grasses dancing as it whipped up from the surrounding valleyed expanse. We had finally reached Mitzpe Dani: small, isolated, and undeniably beautiful.

Mitzpe Dani is a growing community founded by young, idealistic families wanting to build up the remote hills of Biblical Israel. Its excellent vantage point surveys the entire Benjamin region. Its lack of physical boundaries reflects the residents' dream of expansion. But without a fence, the only way to keep out hostile infiltrators is with round-the-clock vigilance and a defensive surveillance framework. On many occasions, Mitzpe Dani has been the target of infiltrations and theft perpetrated by villagers from a nearby large Bedouin Arab settlement. It is only a matter of time before another such incident occurs and escalates into a full-fledged terror attack. So, the community is racing against the clock to ensure that they are prepared and protected.

A sophisticated surveillance camera system is the key to Mitzpe Dani's safety. Last year, thanks to CFOIC donors' support, the community embarked on an ambitious multi-phase security project. They installed eight thermal surveillance cameras, a solar charging system to ensure uninterrupted operation during power outages, and a control center. This system will keep this extremely isolated community safe, allowing its residents to focus on building permanent homes and attracting new families. But funds are still desperately needed to complete the final phase of the project, and the people of Mitzpe Dani need your help.

**Mitzpe Dani needs to purchase and install surveillance cameras to protect its families from hostile infiltrators. You can help protect these godly pioneers, who are doing the crucial work of building up the Biblical Heartland's remote hills.
