SAVING PRECIOUS LIVES

It is a biblical imperative to safeguard human life (Deuteronomy 4:15). For the people of isolated Maale Levona, surrounded by hostile Arab villages on all sides, abiding by this commandment requires constant vigilance. Thankfully, the community's security personnel have been able to thwart recent attacks without injuries or loss of lives, but future success is not guaranteed. The lives of the men, women, and children of Maale Levona are under constant threat, and they are not willing to gamble on precious lives.

In recent years, Maale Levona has experienced booming growth, with new neighborhoods being developed to accommodate the influx of new families. Idealistic couples opt to sacrifice comfort and convenience for a higher purpose—raising their children with a deep and genuine connection to Biblical values and the Land of Israel. Their shared ideology has fueled a warm community bubbling with a rich and rewarding environment. But without proper protection or equipment, their lives are under constant threat of harm.

The community currently protects its residents with round-the-clock perimeter patrols and an electronic fence, which alerts security team members of potential threats. But the fence only detects imminent threats. To truly save lives, the security team must respond to possible attacks before they are underway. They desperately need to purchase and install a comprehensive surveillance camera system. The cameras will alert the security team to potential threats within a buffer area beyond the fence so they can mobilize quickly to best defend against an attack.

Maale Levona's security vehicle is in constant use. Security personnel use the truck every hour for routine patrols, and first responders depend on it during emergency events. Recently, the community raised funds to replace the existing truck and purchased a new vehicle. But they need your help to equip it with life-saving emergency equipment, a defibrillator, and a lockable utility truck bed topper, for storing and transporting the emergency equipment.

Maale Levona needs to purchase a sophisticated surveillance system and emergency equipment to protect its men, women, and children from terrorist attacks. Living in an isolated and vulnerable area, these idealistic pioneers are motivated by their unwavering commitment to fulfilling Biblical prophecy. Your support will ensure their safety and may well save a life. In addition, you have an active role in encouraging Jewish settlement in Biblical Israel.
