SAVING PRECIOUS LIVES

It is a biblical imperative to safeguard human life (Deuteronomy 4:15). For the people of isolated Maale Levona, surrounded by hostile Arab villages on all sides, abiding by this commandment requires constant vigilance. Thankfully, local security personnel have been able to thwart recent attacks without injury or loss of life, but future success is not guaranteed. The people of Maale Levona are not willing to gamble on precious lives.

Despite constant security threats, Maale Levona has experienced booming growth in recent years, with new idealistic couples opting to sacrifice comfort and convenience for a higher purpose—raising their children with a deep and genuine connection to Biblical values and their ancestral homeland. Their shared ideology has fueled a warm community, bubbling with rich and rewarding fellowship. Today, Maale Levona is 150 families strong, with 30 new homes currently under construction and many new families eagerly waiting to join.

For the people of Maale Levona, security is a top priority. Thanks to generous CFOIC Heartland donors, Maale Levona has successfully completed phase 1 of their comprehensive surveillance system, installing infrastructure for the entire system and cameras at the main entrance. This year, they need help with phase 2, including purchasing and installing surveillance cameras at critical points around the community's perimeter and building a structure to house the servers.

Emergency equipment is critical to protecting this isolated community. In rural Israel, power failures occur frequently, especially during winter months. It is imperative that all security systems remain powered up during blackouts. The community's surveillance cameras alert the rapid response team to hostile attacks. But without an emergency generator in Maale Levona, lives are at risk every time the power goes out. Located adjacent to a forest, Maale Levona is also vulnerable to arson terrorist attacks. In Judea and Samaria, Jewish communities often fall victim to fires started by hostile Arabs at the communities' perimeter that spread to homes and endanger lives. To defend local families against such attacks, Maale Levona needs to extend local water infrastructure to the adjacent forest.

Maale Levona needs to purchase an emergency generator, install sophisticated surveillance cameras, and extend its water infrastructure to protect local families from terrorist arson attacks. Living in an isolated and vulnerable area, these idealistic pioneers are deeply committed to fulfilling Biblical prophecy and settling Biblical Israel.
