\$76,840

\$76,840 for special education programs, including therapies and programs for children with learning disabilities, a special needs youth village, afternoon, weekend and day-camp programs for the disabled, an educational enrichment center, and psychological services for at-risk youth. In addition, you supported a regional high school and a Bible School. ●

\$200,190 for needy families in Judea & Samaria including food parcels and hot meal programs in local schools. Support was also provided for recreational and educational programming for senior citizens, as well as assistance for winter heating for needy seniors. ●
