INVESTING IN THE NEXT GENERATION

Six years ago, the ideologically steadfast community of Neve Zuf was compelled to withstand and overcome a tragedy. The Salomon family was hosting a "Shalom Zachar," a celebration traditionally held for male newborns on the Sabbath eve preceding the baby's circumcision and induction into the eternal Abrahamic covenant. A terrorist, determined to destroy the festive ceremony and to break the spirit of the community, entered the Salomon family home, stabbed and murdered three relatives of the family, Yosef, Chaya and Elad.

Residents responded to the tragedy with an unshakable determination by immediately expanding the community and establishing a new neighborhood in memory of the three victims. Invoking each of the first Hebrew letters for the names of the three victims, the community called the new neighborhood "Neve Achi," where residential caravans were set up without delay. In the summer of 2023, the seeds that were planted in heartbreak six years earlier paved the way for the government to authorize the construction of 300 new housing units in Neve Achi, doubling the entire size of Neve Zuf.

The youth of Neve Zuf, taking after their parents, are fiercely dedicated to their community, no matter the hurdles. The teenagers orchestrate an annual 5-K race, including logistics, fundraising, and advertising for the event, in memory of a resident murdered in a terrorist attack. Unfortunately, their local youth center, following years of heavy use, has fallen into disrepair. Initially, the teens attempted to renovate the structure themselves, but without financial resources, their efforts bore little fruit. To make this blessing a reality for these teens, Neve Zuf needs your help to renovate the youth center with new games and equipment.

Neve Zuf is also committed to providing its children and toddlers with spiritual and emotional foundations and building blocks for a stable and secure future. To meet this need, the community created a play center for those children ages 12 and under. The play center however, needs your help to buy furnishings as well as educational toys and games.
