Nofei Nechemia, located east of Ariel in Samaria, is a small, isolated community that has experienced remarkable growth. In just two decades, it has transformed from a barren hilltop into a vibrant religious community, with permanent homes filled with young families and many new families interested in joining. With a bustling community life, including Bible lessons and a close-knit atmosphere, Nofei Nechemia has firmly established itself, putting down permanent roots.

But beyond the community periphery is a sobering truth; Nofei Nechemia is a tiny island in an ocean of mountainous terrain, barren fields, and hostile Arab villages. The people of Nofei Nechemia live in fear of the looming threat of terror. They have experienced their fair share of harrowing encounters with terror, including hostile infiltration, terrorist attacks, and arson. Along the community's perimeter are brush, thorns, rocks, and wild grasses, usually dry from the lack of rain. Tragically, arson has become a favorite weapon against isolated communities like Nofei Nechemia. One match would easily ignite the dry brush, spreading quickly and endangering lives and homes.

Nofei Nechemia has taken proactive measures to address these challenges. They have a dedicated first response team consisting of trained volunteers and are ensuring preparedness for various emergencies. Last year, CFOIC Heartland donors helped Nofei Nechemia purchase protective helmets and a surveillance drone. But they need your continued support to furnish an emergency center, a centralized hub where personnel will gather to coordinate emergency response efforts and purchase emergency equipment, including a backup generator, tactical first-aid kit, and firefighting swatters and blankets.
