SAVING LIVES WITHOUT DELAY

It was a dark, quiet night in Rechalim when three hostile Arabs carrying tires and flammable materials infiltrated through a hole they cut in the community's wire fence. Their sinister plan was simple - to ignite a fire that would spread rapidly through the dry brush, causing harm and spreading chaos. Fortunately, Rechalim's surveillance cameras quickly spotted them and dispatched security team members to the scene. Noticing Rechalim's first responders, the terrorists quickly slipped back out through the hole in the fence. But, the outdated and rusted emergency gate posed a significant obstacle for security team members, hindering them from pursuing the hostiles and the perpetrators slipped away into the darkness.

Rechalim is a vibrant and growing community in Samaria where warmth and camaraderie define everyday life. But, beyond this idyllic setting lies a reality marked by constant security threats. Hostile Arabs from surrounding nearby towns and villages relentlessly attempt to uproot any semblance of a Jewish presence in the Biblical Heartland. Since October 7th, the people of Rechalim have faced a significant uptick in hostile threats. One Friday evening, as families were celebrating the Sabbath, gathered around a festive table, gunfire from neighboring Qabalan pierced the tranquility of Rechalim homes. Four homes were hit, with one bullet passing over the head of a six-year-old boy. Miraculously, nobody was injured, but the incident left families traumatized, feeling vulnerable within their own homes.

The Arab town of Qabalan, a hotbed for terror, is located across the road from Rechalim. Infiltrators easily slip into the community by cutting through the wire fence or simply walking onto to the community where there is no fence. The difficulty in unlocking the rusty gate during the security crisis hindered the rapid response of the security team during the infiltration incident, underscoring the urgent need for an upgraded, quickly opening gate. With daily terror threats looming, round-the-clock patrol of the perimeter is paramount. Rechalim's Utility Task Vehicle (UTV), equipped for rugged terrain, enables security personnel to efficiently patrol the perimeter and respond to potential threats on the undeveloped roads and paths surrounding the community. But after years of wear and tear, Rechalim desperately needs your help to purchase an updated vehicle. Lives are at stake!
